Meeting of Boundaries Sub-Committee of Area 'B', prior to Area 'B' Assembly

Saturday 28th July 2018

at Bunbury Art Galleries, 64 Wittenoom Street, Bunbury, 2.10pm start.

Sue opened the meeting by asking Susan B where Peel District members thought their southern boundary should be. **It was suggested drawing a line east/west just south of Waroona and Boddington and out to Wickepin. Peel District includes Armadale and the northern boundary runs along Armadale Rd, through Cockburn Central and out to Woodman Point.**

Port District's southern boundary is then Armadale Rd (as above) and the northern boundary is the Swan River which is the northern boundary of Area B. **We discussed where the eastern boundary might lay and it was decided on Tonkin Highway, running north/south and west of the airport.**

We then moved on to look at South West District. The northern boundary joins Peel District on a line through Waroona (as above). It encompasses all the land south to Augusta, Walpole,

Denmark and Albany. It was decided that the eastern boundary be Albany Hwy then the Great Southern Hwy running through Tambellup, Katanning and Wagin.

Everyone expressed agreement and the meeting closed at 2.35pm

Discussion regarding best way to inform broader AA members of the new South West District and its boundaries. It was suggested that an article is submitted to Serenity magazine.
